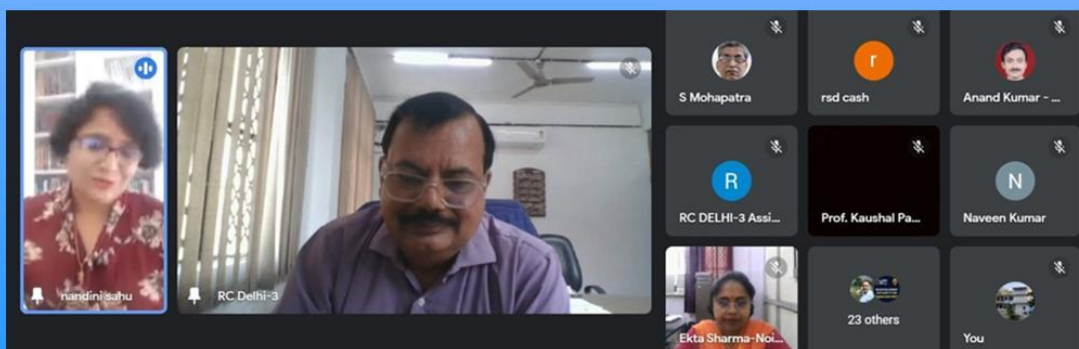

As part of the celebrations of International Women's Day 2023, Regional Centre Delhi-3 organised an online Lecture on 'Gender Discourse : Interaction with a Creative Writer, Nandini Sahu' on 09th March 2023 through Google Meet which was graced by the presence of Dr. S. 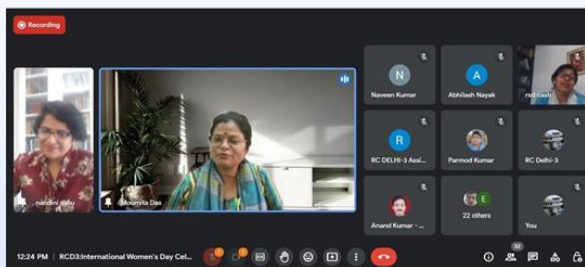

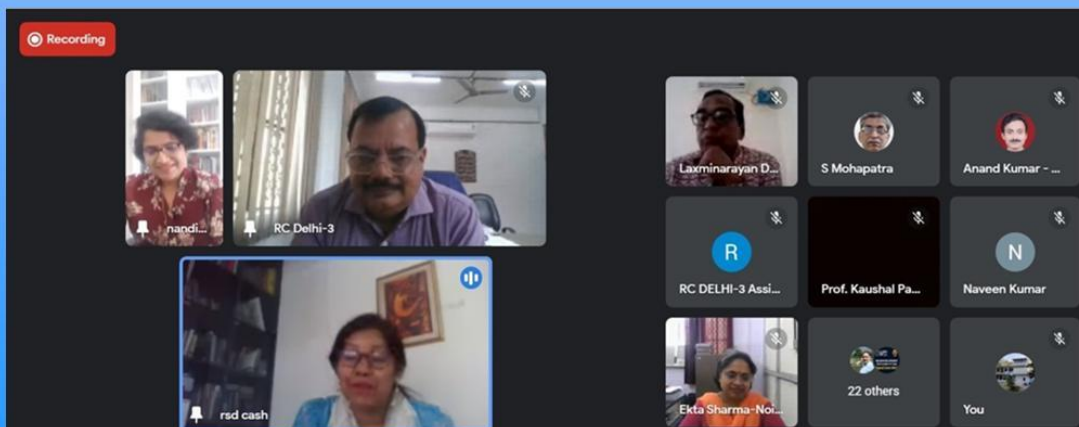


Dr. A. M. Saklani, Regional Director welcomed all invitees to the lecture on the occasion of Celebration of the International Women's Day and thanked Prof. Nandini Sahu for kindly consenting to be the Speaker and Hon'ble PVC Sir for kindly sparing his valuable time to join the lecture. Dr. Ekta Sharma, ARD introduced the Speaker. In his opening remarks, Dr. Mo-

hapatra touched upon the theme with examples from Indian society such as matrilineal societies in some parts of the country and appreciated RC Delhi-3 for organizing the lecture on Gender Discourse. During the lecture, Prof. Nandini Sahu spoke at length about the Gender related issues. She informed that IGNOU is a place where gender equality and gender parity is found to a large extent, much better than many other Universities in the world, and where women are highly respected. She then spoke at length on the theme giving examples from day to day life and from Indian culture and tradition reflected in her writings. She pointed out that within the University, we have a School of Gender and Development Studies and many courses on feminism, and peer studies. She was also very appreciative of the work being done by the Regional Centres.

Dr. Ranjita Panda, Chairperson, RSDCASH shared her own experiences of life and as to what all she faced as a women during her journey of life to reach where she is today. Likewise, Dr. Abhilash Nayak, Sr. Regional Director, RC Patna also shared his thoughts about the role a women plays in our lives as a Mother, as a Home Maker and as a Working women. Dr. Moumita Das, NCIDE spoke about the essence of a woman and the indispensable position she holds in a family system. She described the women as personification of Shakti, timeless loveliness, purity and grace and so on. This was followed by a brief interaction with the participants.

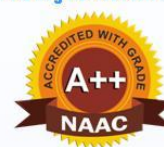

Prof Pragya Pramita, Department of Genetics & Plant Breeding, U P College Varanasi and Prof. Seema Tripathi, Department of Psychology, Buddha PG College Kushinagar were the Resource Persons of the webinar. Dr. U N Tripathi, Regional Director while highlighting the objectives and relevance of the programme welcomed the guest and resource persons and highlighted the issue and perspective of women empowerment.

Dr. Pragya Pramita delivered her presentation on Women in Science: Breaking Through Barriers for Women and highlighted the participation of women in science development across the world. She told that she was 1st woman to study agriculture in Varanasi in 1989. Contribution of women in science development is appreciating but role of women in leading institutional as a head is still far behind. Dr. Seema Tripathi emphasized the status of women in society in her presentation entitled as "Women empowerment in 21st Century". 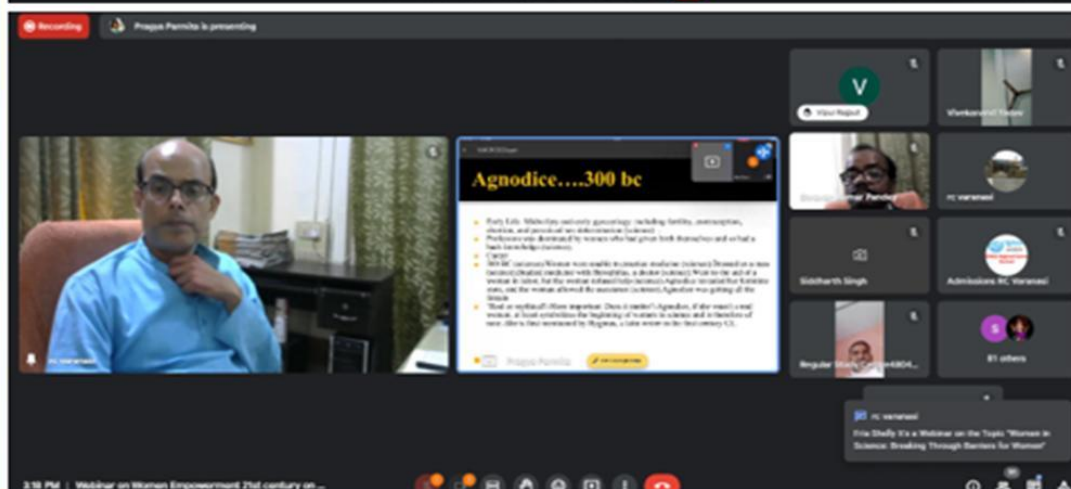
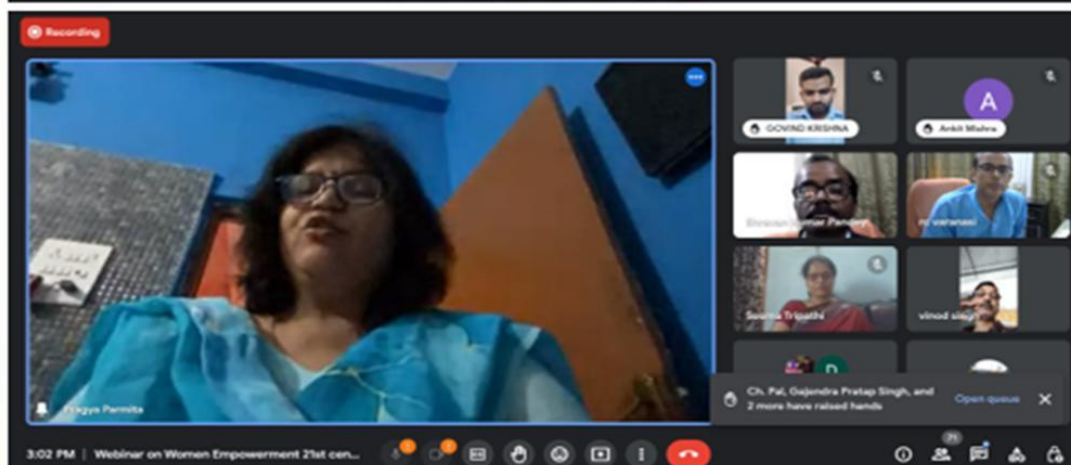
